

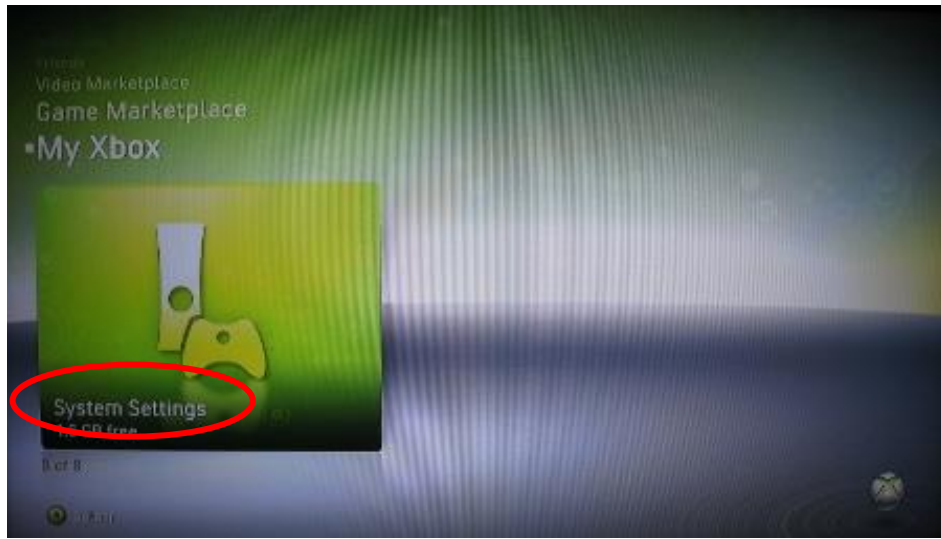
Xbox 360 Networking

Permitting Resident to sign in to Xbox Live

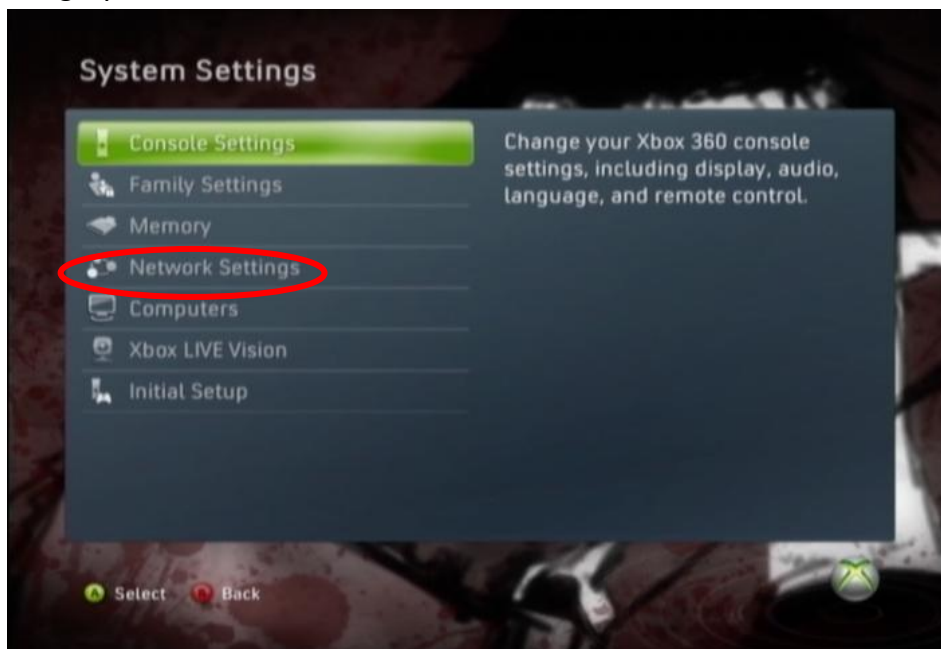
1. Turn on the console after all wires have been connected, this includes the Ethernet cable to the proper outlet.
2. After the system has been powered on make sure you are under the “My Xbox” tab.



3. From there scroll to the right until you reach the “System Settings” sub tab.



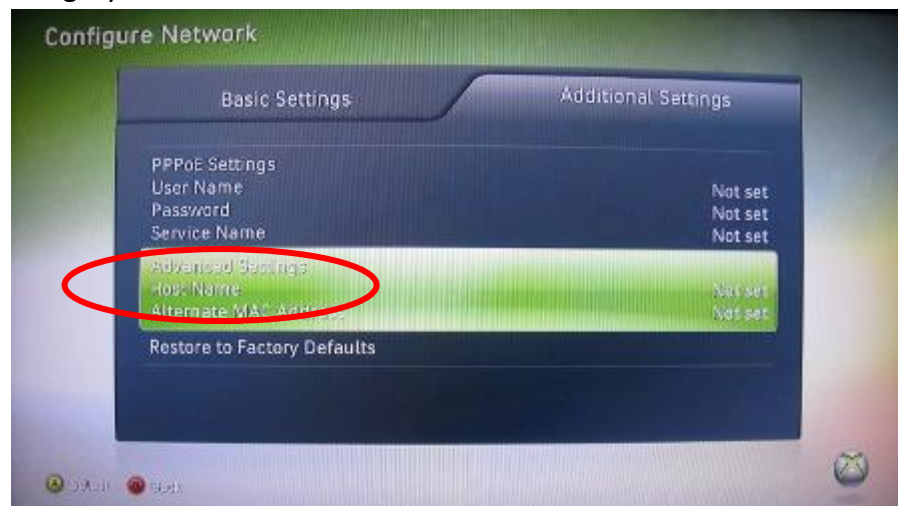
4. Enter “System Setting” via the “A” button and proceed to the “Network Settings” category.



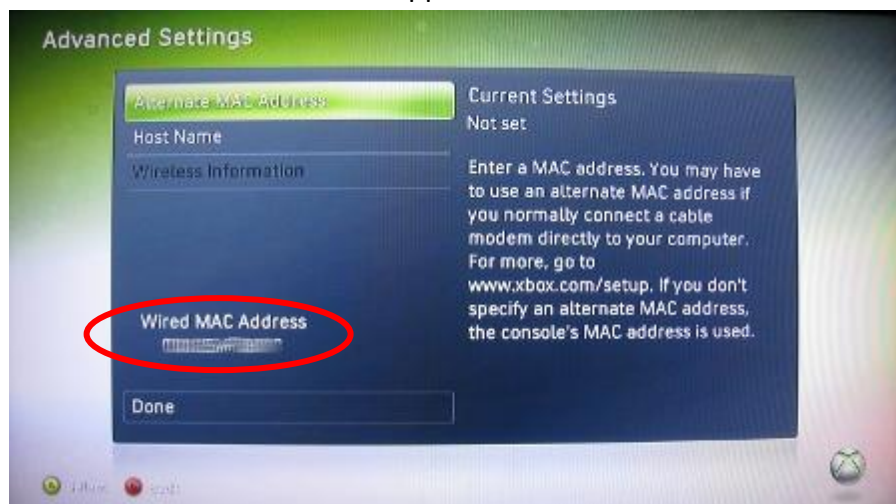
5. Enter the "Network Settings" category and select the "Configure Network" option.



6. Enter the "Configure Network" option and proceed to the "Additional Settings" category.



7. Your Wired MAC Address will appear in the bottom left corner of the screen.



Anti-Virus Software

RMU requires that all machines on the RMU Residential Networks have active Anti-Virus Software installed and running. The RMU IT Help Desk provides information about viruses at www.rmu.edu/virus (Virus Information).

To be considered active, software must receive automatic regular updates from the software vendor and be scanning files for viruses.

RMU allows the use of Norton, McAfee, TrendMicro and other commercial anti-virus packages, provided that the software has an active (paid) subscription and is configured to receive regular updates.


SOPHOS

Operating System Updates

Anti-virus software watches your machine for malicious activity. To prevent the activity from getting to your machine, you need to keep your operating system up to date. Microsoft and Apple provide patches and updates on a regular basis to protect the operating system.

16. Turn the console off for the next 5-10 minutes.
17. Power on the console and go to My Xbox, System Settings, Network Settings, and then Test Xbox Live Connection. If the test passes then the Xbox 360 is signed into Xbox Live and the owner may load his profile and begin playing.

Sony PS3 Networking

Permitting Resident to play PS3 online

1. Power up the PlayStation 3 without any disc in the drive.
2. Once the PlayStation 3 operating system has loaded, select Settings.
3. Once you are in Settings select Network Settings.
4. When the Network Settings list appears, select the first option which is titled Settings and Connection Status List.
5. The physical address will be listed under MAC Address.
